



Shaping a Greener Tomorrow: The Success of the eTwinning Project "FUTURE IS IN NATURE"

We believe that education extends far beyond the pages of a textbook. To truly understand our planet and our role in protecting it, our students must look both outward at the world and deeply into their own backyards. This school year, we did exactly that by participating in the inspiring European eTwinning project, *FUTURE IS IN NATURE*. This international initiative connected our students with peers across Europe (Türkiye, Republic of Moldova, Romania, Georgia) to foster environmental awareness, develop essential digital skills, and build cross-border friendships centered on a vital shared goal: protecting our Earth.

Key Achievements & Activities

- **Local Heritage & Ecology:** Students began by researching and presenting their local environments. Romanian students highlighted Deva and the Fortress Hill nature reserve, introducing European partners to its 1,400+ plant species. Partner schools were also mapped out on a shared digital platform to visualize their global connection.
- **Transnational Collaboration:** Students from different European countries worked together in mixed-school online teams via the TwinSpace platform. This setup helped them practice English, build digital communication skills, and experience active European citizenship.
- **A Musical Manifesto:** The project's final collaborative masterpiece was an original environmental anthem. Students co-authored the lyrics and produced a song video expressing their hopes for the planet.

To celebrate their achievements and growth into responsible digital citizens, every participating student was awarded an official *Certificate of Participation*.

We are incredibly proud of our students' hard work, creativity, and passion for the environment throughout the "FUTURE IS IN NATURE" project. They have proven that the future truly is in nature and that our future is in very safe hands.
